Year 9 Maths Assessment - Friday 15th November

On Friday 15th November all Year 9 students will be sitting their termly assessment in Maths. This will be similar to the assessments that they sat last year and will be based upon the new GCSE Maths Specification. The assessment will cover topics that he/she has been taught in Year 7 and 8 along with topics covered so far this year.

To support your son/daughter's preparation for this assessment, I have attached a booklet of revision questions for them to complete. As a department, we have found that the best way for students to revise is by attempting new questions and using notes, revision guides or MyMaths to help them, alongside their Knowledge Organisers. The booklet is available for students to access on SharePoint and there is also a copy on the school website .

To support them with the completion of this booklet, it will replace the home learning set by their Maths teacher for the weeks commencing Monday 21st October, Monday 4th November and Monday 11th November. Their booklet will be checked by their Maths teacher on Wednesday 6th November and Monday 11th November to make sure they have a minimum of 50% and 75% completed respectively.

To further aid your son/daughter's revision, I have attached the answer booklet to these questions. Please encourage your son/daughter to attempt the questions in the revision booklet prior to checking them in the answer booklet and to seek further help from their maths teacher if they are still struggling with any particular topics. The Maths department are also offering KS4 Maths Drop-in sessions on Wednesday lunchtimes in MA1 where there is a maths teacher available to help them.
