### Exciting Opportunity for KS4 More-Able Mathematicians (Online Lecture)

Dr Sophie Carr is the founder of Bays Consulting. She's always liked playing with Lego which turned into a fascination with aeroplanes – and the start of her career. After training as an engineer, Sophie gained a PhD in Bayesian Belief Networks and has worked in analytics ever since, or to put it another way Sophie has made a living out of finding patterns. This year Dr Sophie was named the World's Most Interesting Mathematician 2019 in an online competition which saw 16 mathematicians from across the world pitch against each other explaining how fun, interesting and relevant Maths is.

She delivered a lecture which you can view online (see details below). As you will see below, it is particularly suitable for students studying A-Level Maths and advanced GCSE Maths students.
