Optional Summer Enrichment Projects

All departments are setting a 'Summer Enrichment Project' for your son/daughter to complete should they wish to do so. Entirely optional, students can access these projects via the Stream option on Google Classroom for each subject. The projects give students a chance to discover and enjoy subject areas that they are interested in beyond the curriculum. For example, the English Department offer their 'summer of reading for pleasure', MFL encourage students to appreciate the history and culture of France and Germany, PE promote the 'Couch to 5K' challenge and the Art Department will explore particular artists' ways of working.
