Message from Mr Kelly Regarding School Closure

You are aware that the School will be closing to most of you at the end of the day today because of the coronavirus situation. We are uncertain about when the School will re-open. We hope that the closure will not be for too long.

We appreciate that this is a very uncertain time and it may be causing you some anxiety.

Please remember what we have told you in assemblies and in form time. It is important to keep calm and follow all the hygiene advice that we have shown you. We are so impressed by your 20 second hand washing! Keep it going!

While the School is closed, we expect you to complete the school work that has been especially set up for you on SharePoint in the areas your teachers have shown you.

It is important to stick to a good routine. Try to get up at the normal time on a school day during Monday to Friday and try to stick to your school timetable. For example, if it is Week A Monday period 1 and you have English then, do 1 hour of English from the resources on SharePoint. Do them in your exercise book, unless your teacher has told you differently. Clearly, you will not be able to do PE, so in that time, do some reading.

We do appreciate that you will not be able to stick to this routine at all times and that some of you will be looking after younger brothers or sisters at times. It is important that you also have family time and time for exercise and relaxation.

Please make sure you behave well at all times and do not cause any disturbances in our local community. Remember- the Government's expert advice is that you stay at home and limit meeting up with others to limit the spread of the virus.

We will be in touch with your parents/carers when we know that the School is reopening.

Until then, please look after yourselves and your families. Keep safe and follow the expert advice about health and hygiene.
