## Advanced notice- Change to dates for start of autumn term 2021 for Years 9, 10, 11 and 13

We are hopeful but uncertain whether current Year 6 students will be able to visit Higham Lane this term for transition activities. If they can't, we will use the virtual activities that we used last year so successfully.

We are making the following changes to support current Year 6 students and to recognise the impact this year has had on our current Year 7 who have only ever been within their bubble area of our school site.

- Monday, 6th September: only the new Year 7, the new Year 8 and the new Year 12 attend school for transition activities. This will enable the new Year 7 and the new Year 8, to see the School fully and to take part in a range of transition activities. The new Year 12 students will also be completing transition activities in the Sixth Form Centre on this day. We will share the timings and the programme of the day with you before the end of the summer term.

-Tuesday, 7th September: students in all year groups: Years 7-13, will attend school.

## Students who are asked to self-isolate

Thanks for all of your support at this very challenging time.

I am sure you will agree that any student who is identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 and is asked to self-isolate by staying at home for a specified period of time, must do so, to prevent the spread of the virus. This is a legal requirement. We are disappointed to hear about particular students who are ignoring this expectation and going out, either during the school day or during evenings and weekends during their self-isolation period and are therefore endangering others. If your son/daughter is asked to self-isolate, please can you kindly ensure they are doing so. (We appreciate that many of you are doing this really effectively and we know it is not an easy situation when the young person's friends are going out). We work closely with our local Police in identifying students who are breaking self-isolation rules.
