This role requires applicants to have a hands-on, practical minded approach with flexibility to adapt to different business demands. The first year of your apprenticeship will be spent at Midland Group Training Services (MGTS) in Coventry learning core practical and theoretical elements of the role. For the following years, apprentices will attend MGTS on a day release basis to complete the necessary educational requirements for the programme.

Skills you will develop include:

- Producing components using hand fitting techniques
- Maintaining Fluid Power equipment
- Wiring and testing electrical equipment and circuits
- Preparing and using lathes for turning operations
- Preparing and using milling machines

Responsibilities and duties will include:

- To understand the technical aspects of blow-moulding process to ensure process parameter control
- To provide hands-on process support to production, correcting and analysing process problems
- To modify parameters and tooling to improve quality and waste elimination
- To police and control all machine parameters, including all parameter records and history
- To oversee tool change-over to ensure product quality, with responsibility for first off
- To provide technical assistance to production and quality in the permanent resolution of corrective actions
- To perform structured improvements, utilising machine programming, material feeds or tooling improvements
