As you are aware, we have made the use of hand sanitiser the main way students will clean their hands at school at regular intervals during the current Covid-19 situation. This is the most practical method for us to use, given that we have a very large number of students, because of the relative number of hand basins we have on site and to ensure we have sufficient time for students to study the full curriculum. We have tried to avoid a situation where students are standing in long queues for wash basins across each day.
