## A huge well done to Year 13 and Year 11 students

Higham Lane School Helping Learners Succeed

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A number of students are arriving early outside of the School gates. Others are gathering in groups on local streets. This has led to some complaints from local neighbours and pedestrians who have found some of our students blocking their way or not distancing from them sufficiently. As you can imagine, this causes particular anxiety at the current time during the COVID-19 pandemic. We are continuously reminding our students to ensure other pedestrians can pass safely and to observe appropriate distancing.

Given that we do not want our students gathering on local streets or gathering in large groups outside the school gates, we have started to bring them on site five minutes before the aforementioned times. For example, Year 7s are called onto the site at Shanklin gate at approximately 8.35 and Year 10s at approximately 8.45. Being on the school site also ensures students are safe.

Please can you support us with this by talking to your son/daughter about this matter. We expect them to co-operate fully with duty staff who call them onto the site.

## **COVID-19 Test Results**

May I please take the opportunity to remind you that should your son/daughter receive a **positive** COVID-19 test result (either via a LFD or PCR test) you should notify the School immediately by email to PositiveTest@highamlaneschool.co.uk or by telephone.

### Stranger Danger

I am sorry that I have had to inform you about several Stranger Danger incidents over the last few days, as reported by our students and those from other schools. I appreciate that this can cause anxiety to your son/daughter and to parents/carers. As you can appreciate, it is designed to raise awareness of potential dangers and the need to be vigilant and also offer students very practical advice about what to do in such situations.

Please can I kindly ask that, **should your child experience a Stranger Danger incident**, **you report the matter to the Police immediately as well as informing the School.** It's important also to be able to provide information that is as specific as possible about the time, location and description of the individual(s). If the matter is reported to us by the student because it has happened on the way to school, we will inform you, as parent/carer, and we will report it to the Police. We will also ask the student for the details.

### End of spring term

This term will finish for students at the current finishing time for each year group on Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> April. Summer term will begin for students at the current start time for each year group on Tuesday, 20th April.
