Outdoor Activity Camp

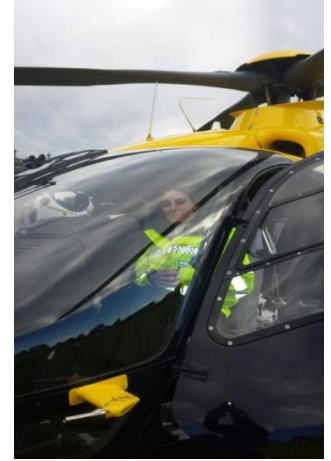
- An outward bound style camp will be held to develop leadership, team work and problem solving skills

Who are we looking for?

To be eligible to be a Senior Cadet, you must:

Live in Warwickshire

be aged at least 16 on 1st September 2022.

and have finished secondary education

(current Year 11 students when applying)



Who are we looking for?

To be eligible to be a Junior Cadet, you must:

Live in Warwickshire

be aged at least 13, 14, 15 or 16 on 1st
September 2022.

and still in secondary education

What's in it for you?

- An evidence based professional developmental folder
- Excellent experience for your CV, job or University applications.
- A unique opportunity to learn about policing and public service.
- An opportunity to meet new people, develop essential skills and have great fun!





Junior & Senior Scheme 13 -18 years how much will it cost?

- The scheme is being financed by a grant from the Warwickshire Police & Crime Commissioner.
- Each cadet will pay a nominal fee of £30 per term time, £90.00 per year towards the scheme
(exceptions can be made in certain circumstances)
- Each cadet will be expected to contribute towards the cost of the annual camp
(exceptions can be made in certain circumstances)



The Recruitment Process

- Step 1: Application Forms can be submitted from 1st Jan to 28th Feb
- Step 2: Assessment Days in March – informal chat with Juniors
- Step 3: Senior Interviews at end of March
- Step 4: Start as a Warwickshire Police Cadet September 2022

- North Warwickshire – North Warwickshire and Hinckley College, Hinckley Road, Nuneaton, Warwickshire.
