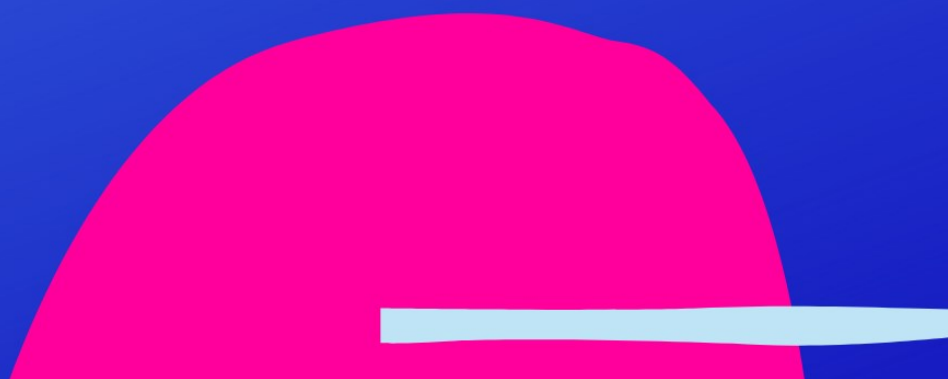

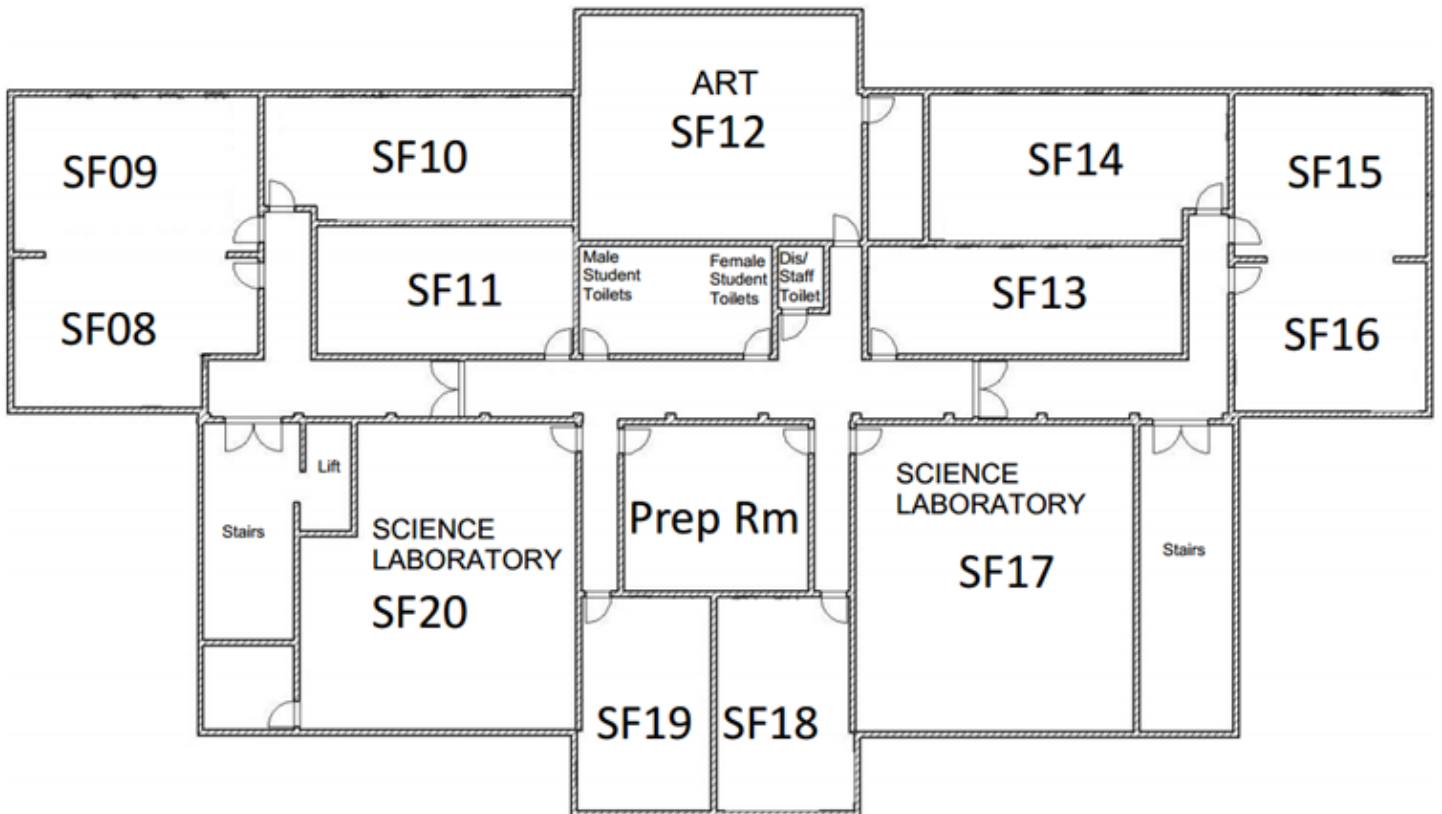

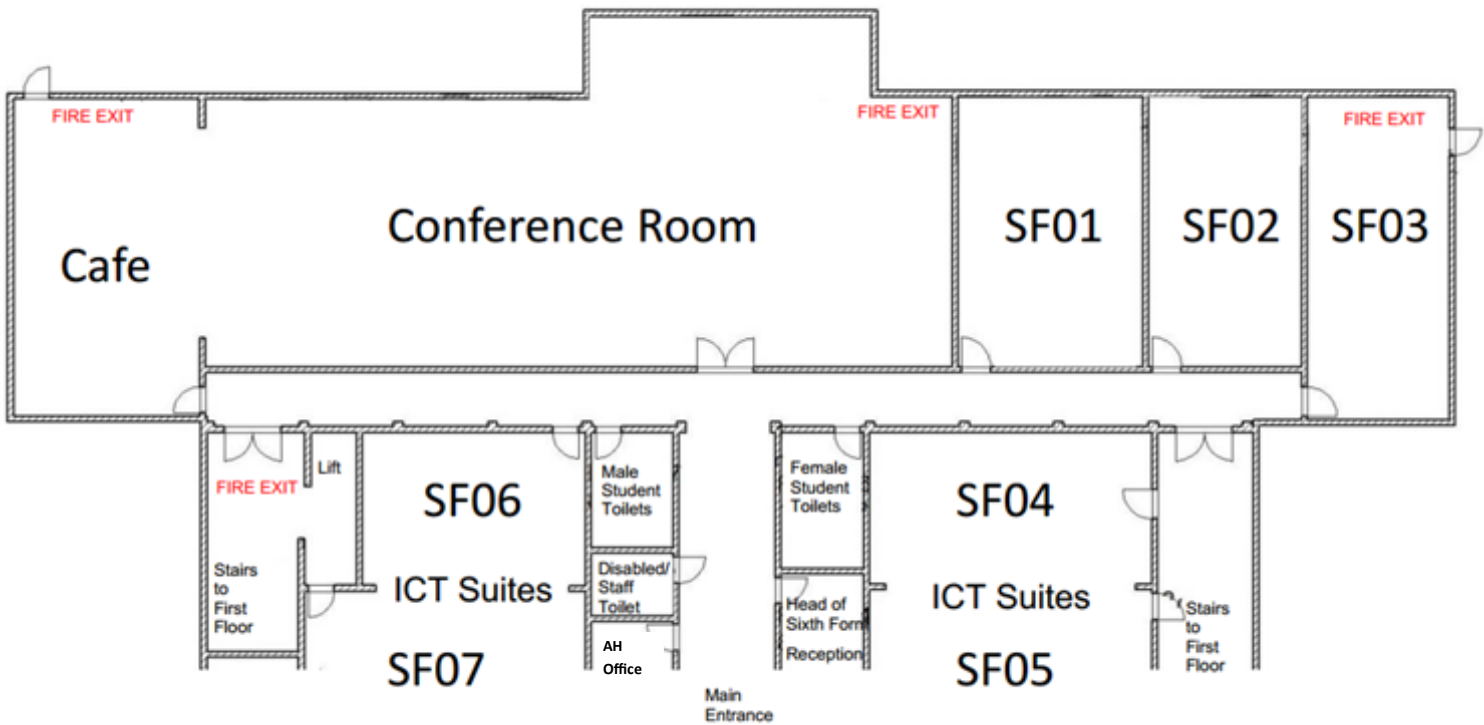

Entry Profile – September 2022

Entry to A level courses requires 5 or more GCSEs at grade 9-4 in different subjects. We strongly recommend that this includes a minimum GCSE grade 4 in English Language and Mathematics. Resits in GCSE Mathematics and English Language will be offered.

Helpful and effective information, advice and guidance is important to us. At enrolment, we are prepared to have a conversation with any student who has not fully met the entry profile.

All subjects will be offering the two year linear A level/vocational route. AS level qualifications will not be offered.
