O: Overall: Summarise the two sides of the argument and provide your opinion.




Analyse (8)

T= Trend: What is the general pattern?

E= Examples: Pick out examples from the figure

A= Anomalies: What doesn't fit the trend?

SSSS: Sliding Scale of Significance

Explain (6/8)


EXPLAIN: Provide reasons why

How to answer A-Level Geography exam questions

Assess (12)



P.E.E. and P.E.E.A.S

P	Point: State your point first of all. <i>It has been suggested that, it is believed that, some people argue that, one argument is...</i>
E	Explain: Give reasons for your point. <i>This suggests that, This leads to, This supports the argument because...</i>
E	Evidence: Must always use a <u>casestudy</u> and a resource if one is provided. <i>This is supported by the example of...</i>
A	Analysis: Think of any problems with this argument. <i>Despite this, The data may not be reliable because..., Nonetheless there is always doubt because...</i>
S	Significance: How important is this point? <i>With this is mind it is evident that, This point is more/less important because, this strengthens/weakens this argument because...</i>
