What happens before and after Christmas?



Use your Purple PLC and RAG Sheets – these are in your book from your trial exam and unit tests and tell you what to focus on



R= Reason for your chosen option: What is your main reason for selecting this option? Think about impacts on the economy, players and the environment.

A= Another 2 reasons for your chosen option: Provide 2 further benefits of your option. Again, think economy, players and environment.

W= Weaknesses of your chosen option: What are the disadvantages of your chosen option?

R= Reasons for not selecting the alternatives: What are the disadvantages of the other two options?



