R070 Using augmented reality to present information (weighting = 30%)

This is assessed by completing a set assignment. In this unit you will learn how to design, create, test and review an Augmented Reality model prototype to meet a client's requirements.

Topics include:

- o Augmented Reality (AR)
- o Designing an Augmented Reality (AR) model prototype
- o Creating an Augmented Reality (AR) model prototype
- o Testing and reviewing.

Grading

All results are awarded on the following scale:

Level 1 – Distinction (D1), Merit (M1), Pass (P1) and Fail/Unclassified.
